TOURNAMENT RULES

All Players must hole out and mark score cards on the first day in the event of bad weather on the second day

- Championship Flight will play the Blue tees
- 2. All Other Flights will play the White tees
- 3. Ladies will play the Red tees
- 4. <u>Day 1</u>- First 9 holes are match plays, 1 plays 2, 3 plays 4 on score card both A & B sides.
- 5. After 9 holes the 2 winners play and the 2 losers play. Next 9 holes are match play also.
- 6. Please hand in your score cards after 18 holes.
- 7. <u>Day 2</u> the winners of A side will play 18 holes, match play for the Flight Championship. The 2 winners of B side will play 18 holes, match play for the consolation prize.
- 8. The **four losers** will team up for 18 holes of **2 man best score match play.**
- 9. All ties will be broken by chip off at green of your final hole.
- 10. Out of Bounds Rules are indicated on your score cards.
- on all Par 4 & 5 Holes, lost balls or out of bounds off the tee box, go to drop flag. Penalty 2 strokes. (e.g. Shooting 4)
- 12. On all Par 3 Holes, lost ball or out of bounds off the tee box, go to drop flag. Penalty 1 stroke. (e.g. Shooting 3)
- 13. Maximum three minutes time looking for lost ball.
- 14. Team Captains/Scorecard holders must complete score cards at completion of round and turn into committee member at the club house.
- 15. Champion Flight will play metal play both days with handicaps. Maximum strokes given is 8.
- 16. Putts within 18" are to picked up for 1 stroke. Black band on the bottom of the Flag Stick is 18".

HOLE-IN-ONE RULES

- 1. First in on the designated hole will be the winner.
- **2.** All shots must be made in the regular round of play in the tournament by a registered participant with no practice shots permitted.
- 3. The participants must complete all score cards.
- 4. A course marshal or adjudicator must be stationed and monitoring play at the selected hole at all times during the tournament.
- 5. In the case of a hole-in-one, certification of achievement must be made on the score card of the participant achieving the hole-in-one by the course marshal and all participants within the group in which the hole-in-one was made.
- **6.** The tournament must be played in groups of three or four. *No twosomes allowed.*
- **7.** A ball hit out of bounds or replayed for any reason does not qualify as a hole-in-one. This would constitute as a hole-in three.
