Tournament After Party at the OTS Hall

- Hall will be opened for cocktails at 1:00 PM.
- Due to City of Edmonton regulations, a Mask must be worn in the hall, except when seated at a table.
- Due to Alberta Heath Services regulations, we are restricted to a maximum of 50 people in the hall at any time, consequently:

- Hole and Door Prizes will be drawn winners do not have to be present to win. Prizes will be delivered to winners not in attendance.

TOURNAMENT RULES

All Players must hole out and mark score cards

- 1. All Flights will play the Deck 2 tees
- 2. Ladies will play the Deck 4 tees
- **3.** 2 vs. 2 Combined Net Scoring System. Both players per team will play their own ball and combine their scores for the hole. The team with the lowest combined NET score gets a point. The team with the most points after 18 holes wins.
- **4.** If there is large difference in team handi-caps, strokes can be negotiated prior to the start of the match.
- **5.** All Ties will be decided via a Countback
- **6.** Scores are for all players must be entered so that we can determine an overall Team and Individual winner.
- 7. All ties will be broken by chip off at green of your final hole.
- 8. Out of Bounds Rules are indicated on your score cards.
- **9.** On all Par 4 & 5 Holes, lost balls or out of bounds off the tee box, go to drop flag. Penalty 2 strokes. (e.g. Shooting 4)
- **10.** On all Par 3 Holes, lost ball or out of bounds off the tee box, go to drop flag. Penalty 1 stroke. (e.g. Shooting 3)
- **11.** Maximum three minutes time looking for lost ball.
- **12.** Team Captains/Scorecard holders must complete score cards at completion of round and turn into committee members at the golf course.

HOLE-IN-ONE RULES

- **1.** First in on the designated hole will be the winner.
- 2. All shots must be made in the regular round of play in the tournament by a registered participant with no practice shots permitted.
- **3.** The participants must complete all score cards.
- **4.** A course marshal or adjudicator must be stationed and monitoring play at the selected hole at all times during the tournament.
- **5.** In the case of a hole-in-one, certification of achievement must be made on the score card of the participant achieving the hole-in-one by the course marshal and all participants within the group in which the hole-in-one was made.
- **6.** The tournament must be played in groups of three or four. *No twosomes allowed.*
- **7.** A ball hit out of bounds or replayed for any reason does not qualify as a hole-in-one. This would constitute as a hole-in three.
